

The Need

- Legislation creating UF Online mandated emphasis on FTIC enrollment
- Increase access to UF
 - Cap on Freshman class of 6700 students
 - 30,000 FTIC applications





The Idea

- Student who was not admitted to campus due to lack of space
- Offered admission to Pathway to Campus Enrollment (PaCE) program
 - Enroll in UF Online for a minimum of 1 year
 - Complete 60 credits and all critical tracking requirements
 - Guaranteed admission to main campus program (in the same major) at the upper-division level

While we have limited physical space on campus to accommodate the many students who desire a UF education, PaCE provides you with the chance to start your degree online and then transition to campus in order to complete it. The PaCE program offers an excellent academic experience, combining online and campus-based learning.

 - Facebook discussions





- 259 confirmed (8%)
- 256 enrolled
 - (1.2% melt)

- 446 confirmed (21%)




Pace 2.0 Confirms Profile
