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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The number of enrolled 2013-2014 ACT-tested freshmen (1238375) represents those students that nationwide participating institutions identified as enrolled full-time. The average ACT composite score for ACT-tested enrolled freshmen was 22.5 (men = 22.8, women = 22.2). The national ACT composite for 2012-2013 high school graduates was 20.9.
